

## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

#### 1. What is the warranty on the LIFESTYLE SCREEN system?

The LIFESTYLE SCREEN has a Limited Lifetime warranty covering the parts. Screen mesh is not included in this warranty. Check with your installer on any labor warranty.

#### 2. Does it interfere with my regular garage door?

No. The LIFESTYLE SCREEN works in conjunction with your existing garage door, allowing you to quickly switch between your garage door and your LIFESTYLE SCREEN system. The system rolls easily on its own tracks to store directly under your existing garage door. When in use, the LIFESTYLE SCREEN exchanges positions with your garage door, filling the same space in your garage opening.

#### 3. How long does it take to install?

The LIFESTYLE SCREEN system can be installed by a trained professional installer in two to four hours.

#### 4. What sizes are available?

LIFESTYLE SCREENS are available in widths of 6' - 18' in 7' and 8' heights and in widths of 8' - 16' in 9' and 10' heights. Both widths and heights can be custom fit to odd-size openings.

#### 5. What frame colors are available?

Currently, frames are available in white, brown and sandstone finishes.

# 6. How much clearance will I lose from my existing garage door opening when the LIFESTYLE SCREEN is installed? Typically, you will not lose more than 1.75" of headroom as the LIFESTYLE SCREEN sits directly under the existing garage door.

#### 7. Must the car be out of the garage for the screen to come down?

Not necessarily, but that depends on the vehicle size and garage length.

#### 8. Must the pass thru door be located in the center?

No, it is possible to install the door in a location other than the center of the unit, although the manufacturer suggests installing the door in the center for the best possible operation. Extrusions are pre-drilled for center location so plugs should be installed to cover existing holes.

#### 9. Are different types of screen material available instead of the standard screen mesh?

The LIFESTYLE SCREEN is available with the standard 18x14 fiberglass mesh as well as optional 17x20 PVC coated polyester SuperScreen available in white and black, offering greater privacy, additional insect protection, pet resistance, extended durability, and solar protection.

#### 10. What type of air flow do you get with the different screens?

You will get approximately 10% more airflow with the standard screen (58%) compared to the SuperScreen (48%).

#### 11. Must the garage door be open to use the LIFESTYLE SCREEN?

Yes. The screen fits in the opening in the same space as the existing garage door. When the LIFESTYLE SCREEN is in place, the electronic opener safety beams are blocked, preventing the garage door from being operated.

#### 12. How wide is the sliding pass thru door?

36"

#### 13. Can you add a locking mechanism to the retractable door?

Yes, the retractable door can be fitted with a lock at an additional cost. Locking mechanisms are optional.

# 14. I have storage over my garage doors now. Can the LIFESTYLE SCREEN and my garage door go down so I can access this area?

Yes, you will want to open your garage door and then roll your LIFESTYLE SCREEN down until it touches the floor, leaving it "kicked back" from the jamb. Then simply disconnect your garage door from the opener with the safety disconnect cord and gently roll the garage door down until it rests on the LIFESTYLE frame.

#### 15. Does the garage door opener arm conflict with the LIFESTYLE SCREEN?

Most operator J-arms can be adjusted to accommodate the LIFESTYLE SCREEN.

#### 16. What type of radius does the overhead door track need to be for the screen door to work properly?

The LIFESTYLE SCREEN will work with 12", 15", 20" and 32" radius.

#### 17. How can you perform service work on a garage door (i.e. spring replacement) if the screen is up?

See #14 above. You can also release the extension springs by unhooking the "S" hooks and then push the LIFESTYLE SCREEN door back as far as possible. Then clamp the LIFESTYLE so it doesn't roll forward. This will allow you to get between the LIFESTYLE door and the front of the garage to replace the springs. If you need more work space, you can take the LIFESTYLE completely out of the opening and then re-install.

#### 18. Are there some garages you cannot install a LIFESTYLE SCREEN in?

In some cases, a LIFESTYLE SCREEN cannot be installed i.e. when the existing garage door cable is an "outside cable hookup" or has a double track low headroom system. Sometimes a service door or door to the home swings into the location of the LIFESTYLE SCREEN track system which may not allow a LIFESTYLE SCREEN without a change to the swinging door.

#### 19. Where can I buy a LIFESTYLE SCREEN?

We have made a commitment to sell only through a network of trained dealers.

#### 20. Can the screen be operated by remote control?

No, the LIFESTYLE SCREEN is designed to be operated manually.

#### 21. Does the system work with wind-loaded doors such as those found in Florida and other coastal areas?

Yes, the LIFESTYLE SCREEN works with all wind loaded and hurricane reinforced doors. However, if your door is reinforced with 6-inch C-channels, you should discuss the changes necessary with your installer.

#### 22. Is the LIFESTYLE SCREEN system the same as the Breezy Living Screen Solutions system?

Advanced Screenworks licensed the patented technology to a company that manufactured and sold the product under the name Breezy Living. The license agreement has since ended. Advanced Screenworks is now the sole manufacturer of this product, now branded under the LIFESTYLE SCREEN name. Although numerous refinements to the components have been made to the product based on feedback from the field, the LIFESTYLE SCREEN still functions the same.

#### 23. Can I install my LIFESTYLE SCREEN system myself?

The LIFESTYLE SCREEN is not sold directly to consumers but dealers are free to sell the units to do-it-yourselfers. The product comes with installation instructions but it should be noted that the units have a spring-loaded balance system and care should be taken when installing the product. Step-by-step installation instructions and videos are provided.
